

2022 FAOF Group Project Information—for Coordinator and participants

GROUP PROJECTS ARE GENERALLY DEFINED AS ITEMS MADE IN RESPONSE TO A GUILD CHALLENGE OR MADE DURING A GUILD WORKSHOP.

Each group project must have a coordinator. The coordinator is responsible for 1) providing FAOF with a group name, 2) a written description of the challenge or workshop which will be placed on the wall next to the entries and a list of group members and the titles of their pieces, and 3) hanging the group project pieces in the space designated by the FAOF committee on Thursday morning Nov 3, 2022. Any special information such as winners in a challenge, name of workshop teacher, etc should also be included in the description. There will only be ONE wall sign for the entire group—no signs on individual pieces. **There should be a minimum of 3 pieces in any group.** Coordinator should send all required information to Chris Deering (chris@toldme.com) by September 12, 2022.

Group participants complete the same exhibit form as other exhibit items and are held to the same requirements; the only difference is that you should check off and identify the name of the group project you are submitting (please check with your group coordinator). Write GROUP PROJECT/[Name of Project] at the top of the form. **Group projects have a nonrefundable entry fee of \$5.**

FAOF GUIDELINES:

- Individual pieces in group entry can be for sale or not. Submission forms for sale entries must be accompanied by a completed W-9 form (available on FAOF website under Forms)—one W-9 per individual.
- The project piece will *not* count as your primary piece. Each person in group project may have 1 additional piece in the show, and more if space permits.
- Each person with work in the show is expected to work a 2.5 hour shift, even if it's only the group entry. If any work is for sale, a 2nd shift is required. Extra shifts encouraged!

If a multi-piece group project is sold, check will be written to and mailed to group coordinator for appropriate distribution to group members.

There must be a coordinator for any group; if there is no coordinator, entries are not eligible for the \$5 entry fee--items will be considered a standard entry, pay a \$10 fee, and will not necessarily be placed together in the show.

ENTRY FORM for group project piece:

- At the top of the entry form, please write and highlight: “GROUP PROJECT/[Name of Project].” Check off group project on the appropriate line and provide the group name defined by coordinator
- Again, a separate entry form is required for each piece entered for a group project. There is a \$5 nonrefundable entry fee for each group project item. Make checks payable to the Fine Art of Fiber and submit with entry form and photo.
